

## Playing Card #7 (The Plot Against Jesus)

**Wednesday Read:** Matthew 26:14-16

**Do:** Fill a plastic lunch baggie with 30 silver coins (dimes or nickels) and tape this card to the bag.

Jesus was betrayed by his friend and disciple—Judas! Judas sold him for a small amount of money, but God turned it into good by really exchanging Jesus' life for yours and mine, and your families, and anyone else that wants to know Him!

## Playing Card #9 (Jesus Comforts The Disciples)

**Thursday Read:** John 14:1-16:33

**Do:** Jesus informs them of the third person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit. When I was young, I didn't understand the Holy Spirit. Then one year after I got married, Mr. Robert and I lived in Fresno, California and one day we went to church and I began a relationship with Him. This relationship with the person of the Holy Spirit changed everything for me!

Worship the Lord as a family and ask for the Holy Spirit to fill your family, your home, your hearts, and move in whatever way He wants to!

## Playing Card #11 (Jesus' Arrest And Trial)

**Thursday/Friday Read:** Matthew 26:47-27:26

**Do:** Read the prophesy (this was the Truth before it actually happened) in Zechariah 13:7-9. The people heard this scripture but didn't know what it meant until years and years later when Jesus was in the Garden of Gethsemane. This is what it means when they say that the "prophesy is fulfilled." Place this card in Zechariah 13:7 in your Bible.

## Playing Card #8 (The Last Super)

**Thursday Read:** Matthew 26:17-29

**Do:** After your family eats dinner, have a communion time together. If you don't have bread or grape juice, use whatever you have! One time I broke my fast with communion and only had rice cakes and water. The Lord didn't mind at all. In fact, He and I shared a sweet time together as we communed. Enjoy in a communion celebration together as a family. This will remind you of what's going to happen to Jesus tomorrow.

How do you do communion as a family? Fill a cup with juice or water, get some bread, crackers, etc. and take a bite/sip of each. Listen to worship music as you enjoy spending time with Jesus together.

## Playing Card #10 (Gethsemane)

**Thursday Read:** Matthew 26:36-46

**Do:** Go to a garden or under a tree with your family and pray together. Talk about what Jesus must have felt like as he prayed to God knowing what was about to happen to him.

## Playing Card #12 (Jesus Crucifixion & Death)

**Friday Read:** Matthew 27:27-56

**Do:** Draw or make a cross. Let this remind you of the Love that Jesus had for you by dying on this cross for you. This is a picture of the actual place that Jesus walked as he was dying.
